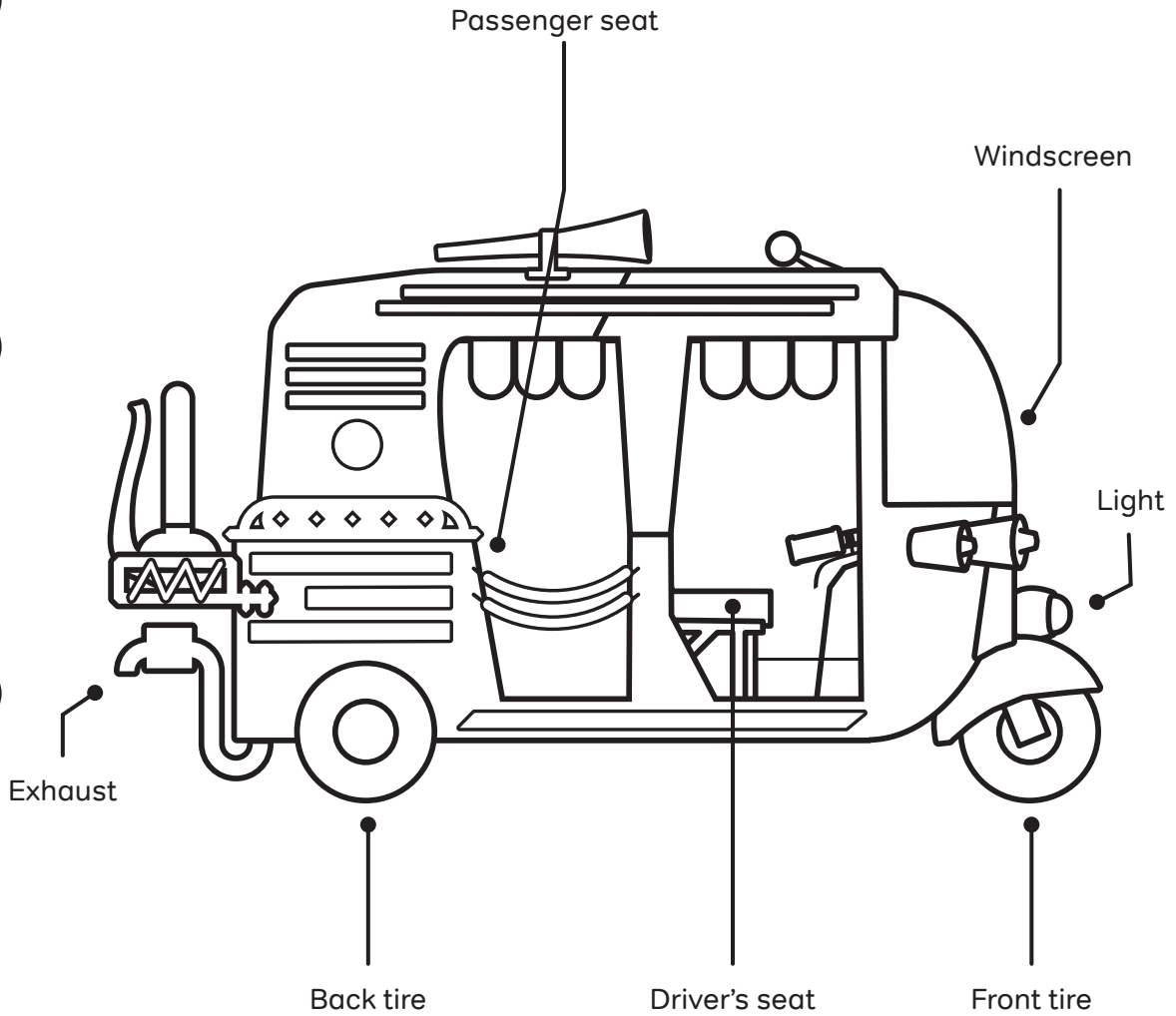


Tuk Tuk

Owner's Workshop Manual

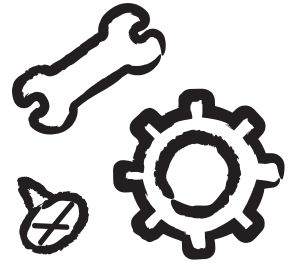
- Popular in many countries including India, Ethiopia and Cuba
- Three-wheeled vehicles usually used as taxis
- Inspired by rickshaws which were pulled along by people or bikes
- Little in size making them easy to drive around crowded places
- Called 'tuk tuks' because the name is similar to the noise they make!
