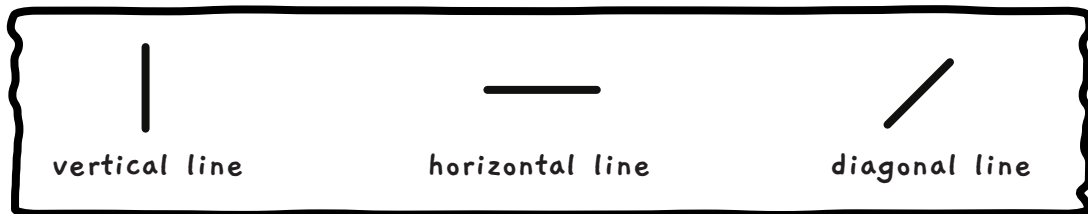
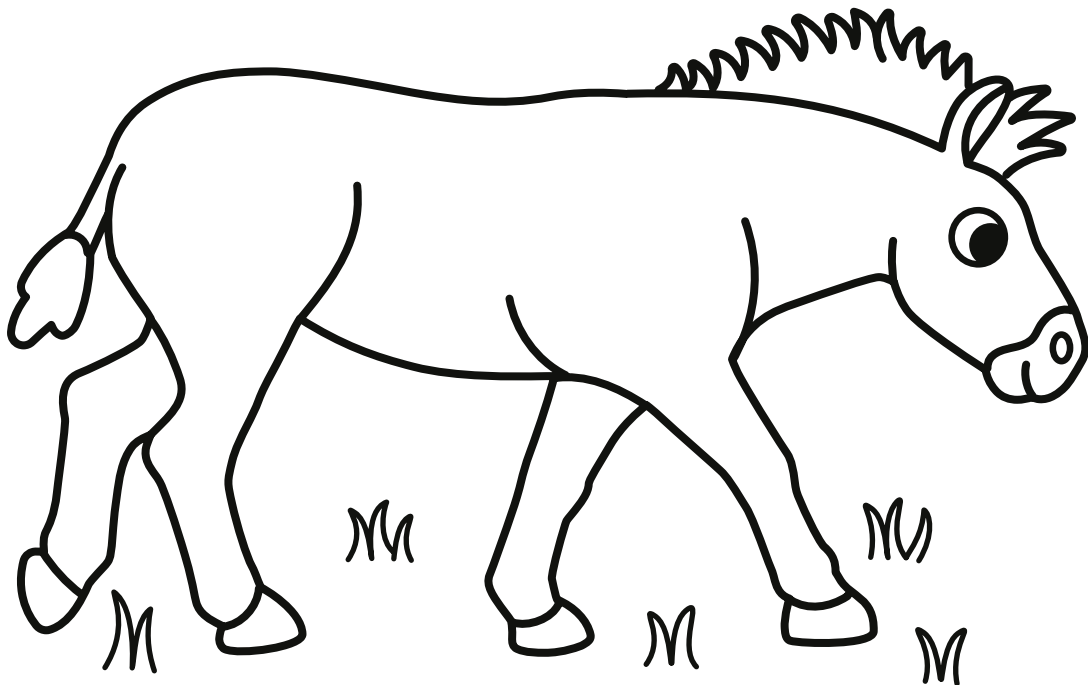

Learn about diagonal, horizontal, and vertical lines.

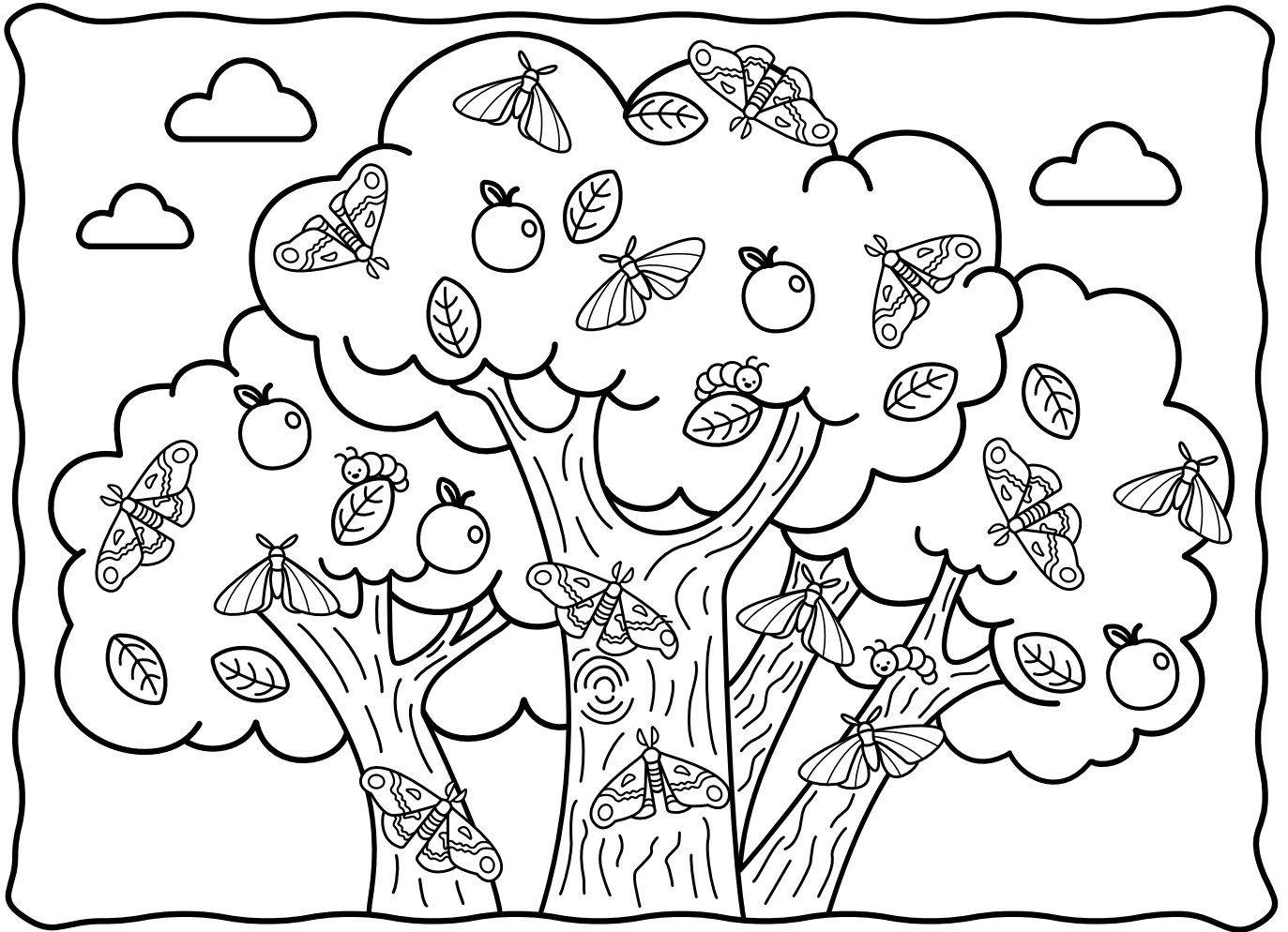
Tip

Ask why a moth would want to stay hidden.

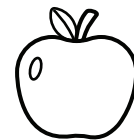
