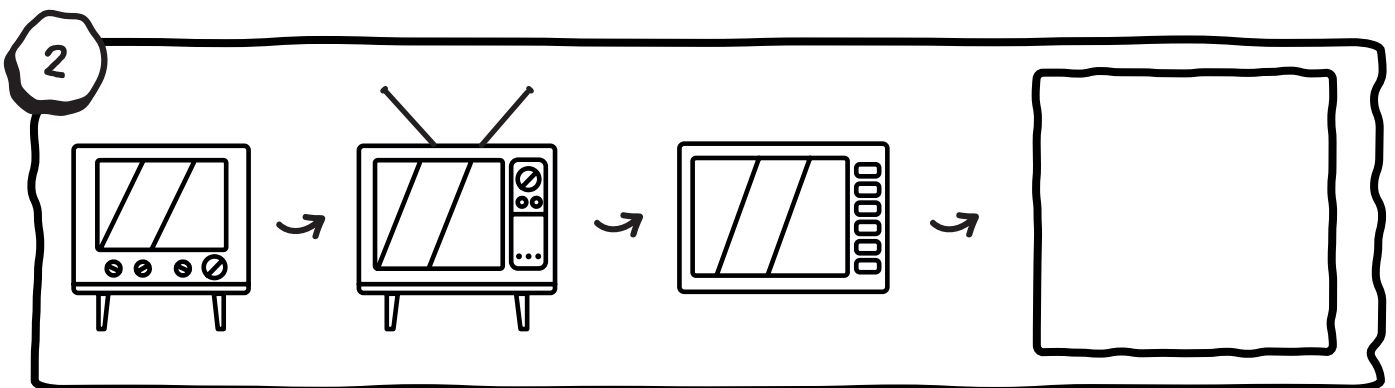
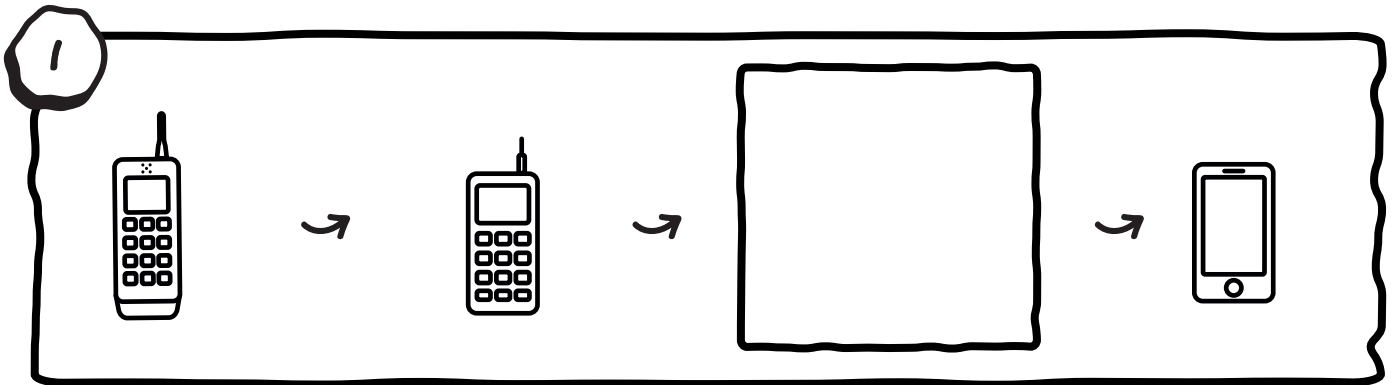


Math Mysteries

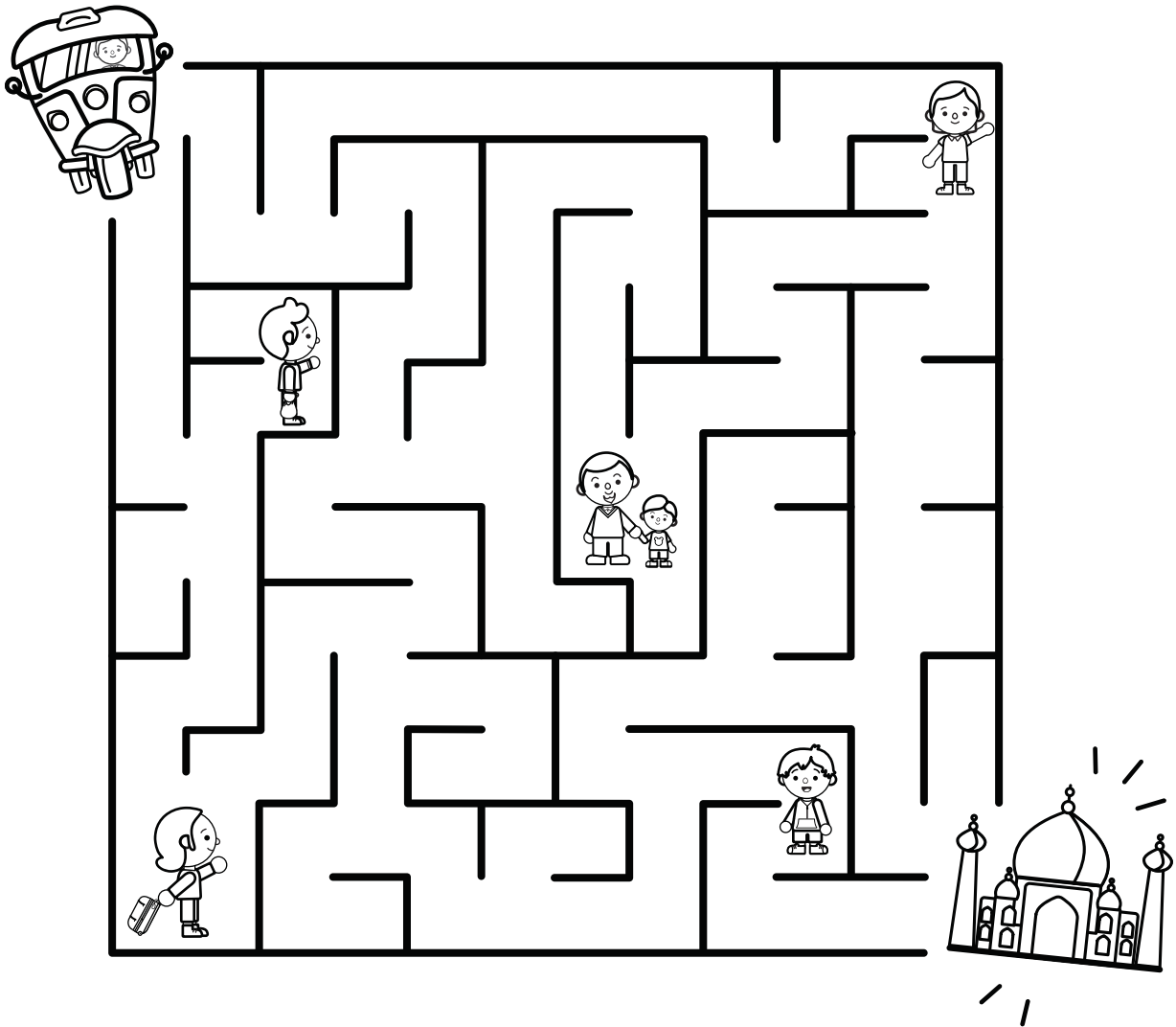

Supports critical thinking skills and spatial awareness.

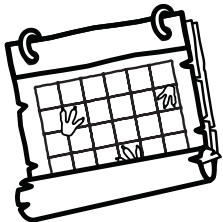
Tip

Ask your child if there is another route in the maze that would allow them to pick up more passengers.

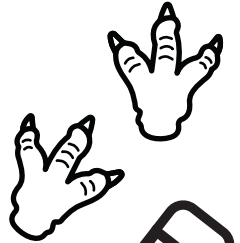
