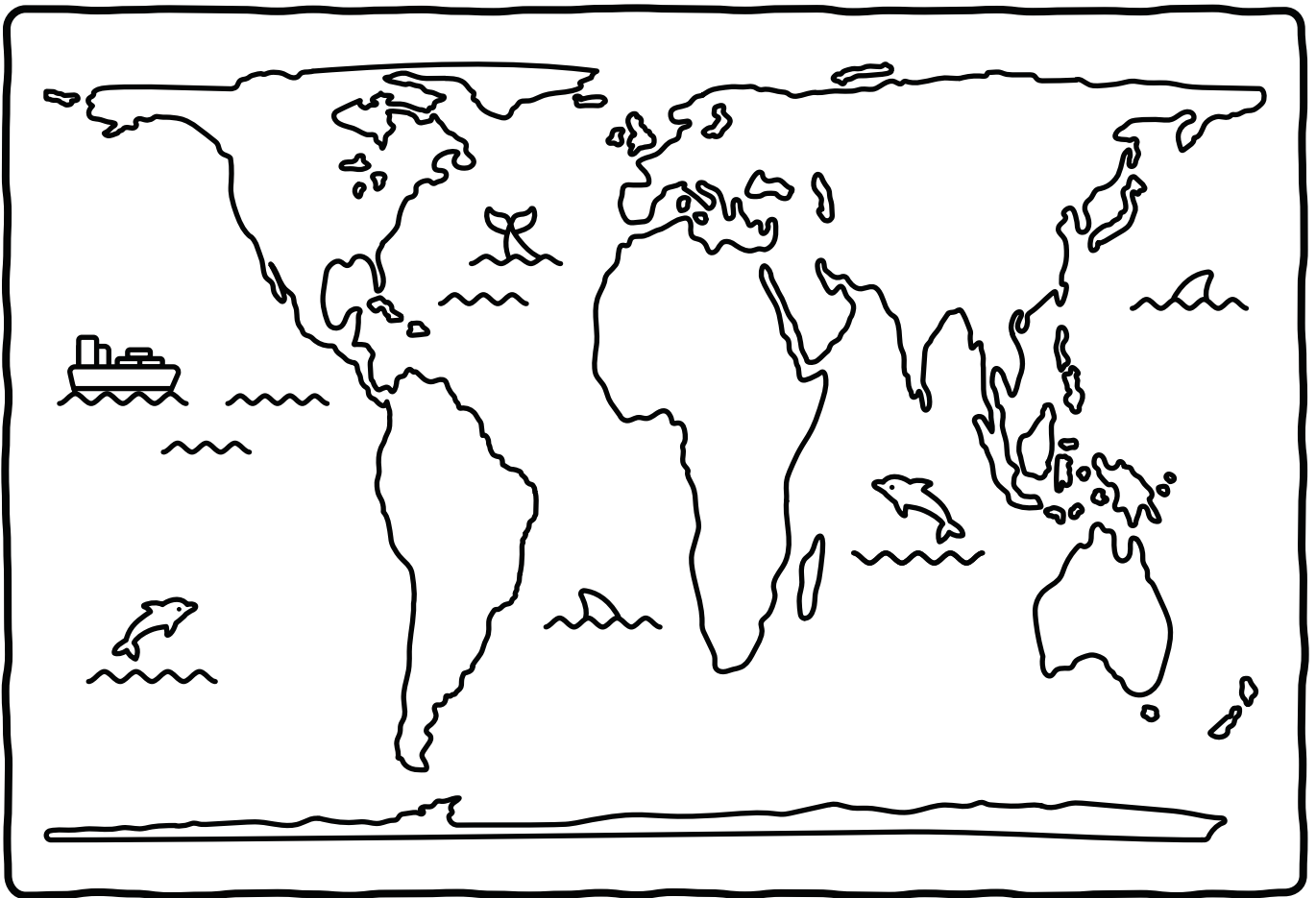

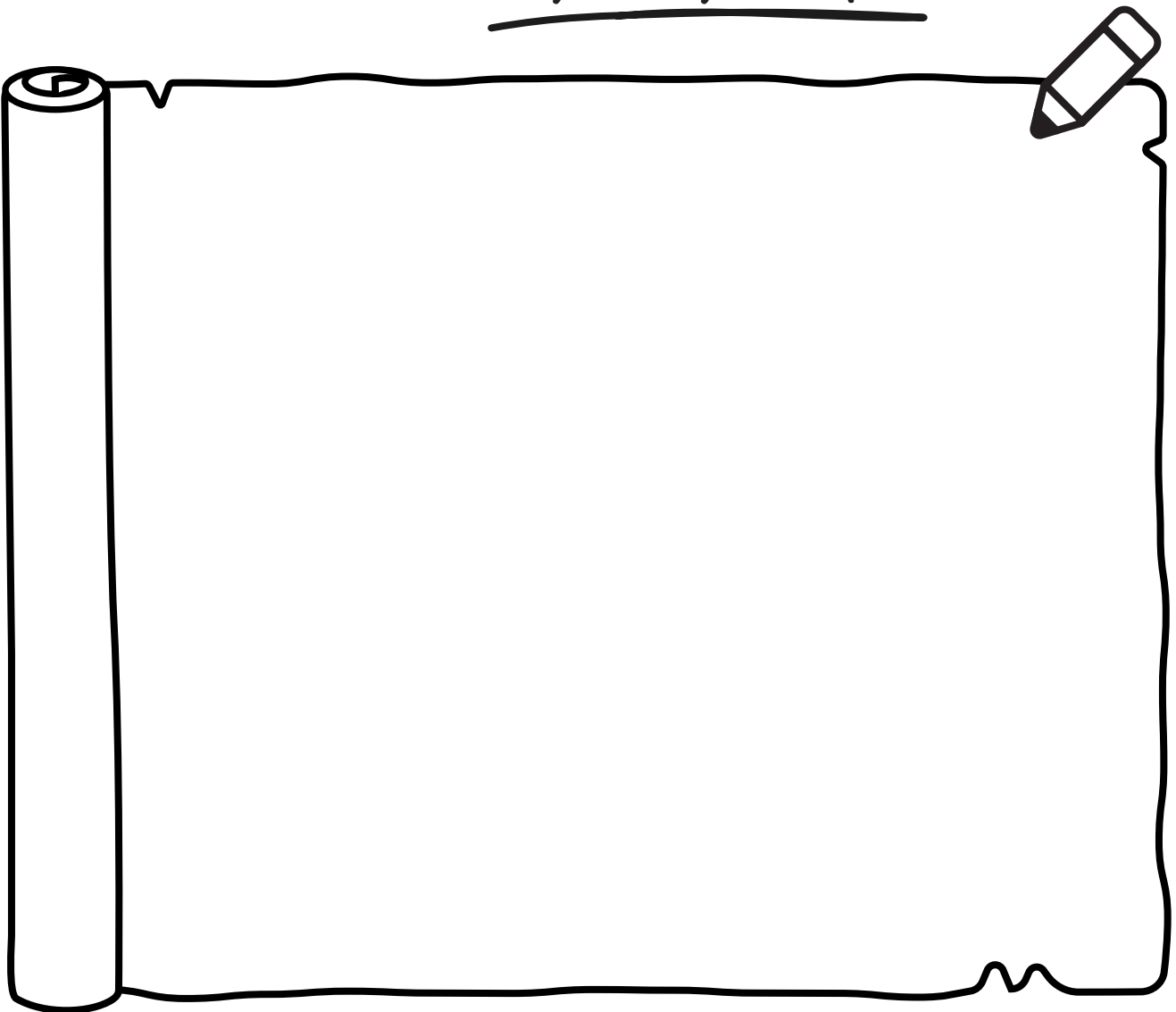

Ask your child if their map includes a title.

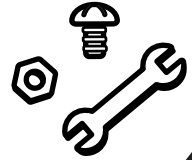


Story Time
